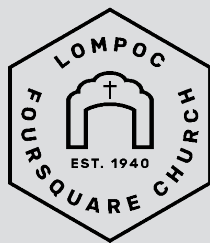

## THE CHURCH ON MONDAY: OPEN FOR BUSINESS

*Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come:[a] The old has gone, the new is here! (1 Corinthians 5:17)*

Part of being “made new” in Christ involves living out a new calling. Jesus has commissioned us to be His “ambassadors” in His work of reconciling the world to God. This is the ministry, or mission, to which we are called.

(1 Corinthians 5:18-20, Matthew 28:16-20, Ephesians 1:22-23, Colossians 1:15,10)

### **Our mission requires us to realize:**

The essential gospel centers on the person of **Jesus Christ**, not the **church**

The church is “**His Body**” and the “**fullness** of Him”. (Ekklesia – “the called out ones”)

The **model** for the church (us) is Jesus

“Incarnational Christianity” can only be accomplished by **people** not **institutions**

(What is incarnational Christianity? – it’s Jesus in the flesh)

Jesus is the “**fullness of God**”

**Strategic Placement:** Christians are people of destiny, purposely placed by God deep inside our culture. (Jerry Cook)

Some of us are **WHERE** we are supposed to be, but we aren’t being **WHO** we are supposed to be.

You are the church of God and key to the mission of God to reconcile the world to Himself. The question He is asking is: “Are you open for business?”
