In Galatians 1 we hear Paul's deep concern that the people he loves are turning aside from the gospel and trying to earn their salvation. As Chapter Two opens, Paul reminds the Galatians that salvation by grace has always been at the core of the gospel message.

James 4:6, 1 Peter 5:6-7, Epnesians 2:11-14, Psaim 133, Acts 15:28-29
A teachable spirit is a powerful and <u>unifying tool</u>
Humility invites God to work on your behalf.
"God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." (James 4:6b NLT)
Let's not be embarrassed to have questions
God was creating one family out of very different people
Being united with Christ means being united with his people
How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! 2 It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron's beard, down on the collar of his robe (Psalm 133:1-2)
Any partiality we show one another in the church is a by-product of our brokenness not God's Spirit.
We aren't meant to be governed by culture, but by Jesus
Correct doctrine is never a substitute for Christian duty
